Structure of the Agile PM<sup>™</sup> Foundation Examination

- The Agile PM™ Foundation examination is a one hour long, multiple choice paper of 60 multiple choice questions
- 30 marks required (out of 60 available) to pass 50%
- Four styles of questions
  - o Standard
  - o Negative
  - o Missing words
  - o List
- Closed book
